Students are drawn to Cedar Creek from rural communities, small towns, and mid-sized cities from seven parishes by the school's reputation for academic excellence. Cedar Creek practices an open non-discriminatory admission policy.

### CURRICULUM AND GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Cedar Creek School offers an expanded college preparatory curriculum. Career internship opportunities are available for seniors. **Cedar Creek School does not rank its students**, rather a quartile is determined, based on all students and on all subjects. All subjects are college preparatory. Grade point average is weighted. Honors, Advanced Honors, and Advanced Placement courses receive additional weight.
