2026–2027 Program Guide and Fee Schedule

Cedar Creek Accelerated Program (CCAP): The Cedar Creek Accelerated Program (CCAP) provides specialized instruction for students with language-based learning differences and other documented academic needs. CCAP is designed to provide individualized instruction, remediation, progress monitoring, and educational support while allowing students to remain active members of the Cedar Creek community.

Our Mission: CCAP is Cedar Creek School's comprehensive academic support program dedicated to helping students become confident, successful, and independent learners.

Through individualized instruction, evidence-based intervention, academic consultation, and collaborative partnerships with families and teachers, CCAP equips students with the skills and strategies necessary to achieve their fullest academic potential while remaining fully engaged in the life of Cedar Creek School.

Recognizing that every student learns differently, CCAP provides a continuum of services designed to meet students where they are academically and help them achieve long-term success.

Our Philosophy: At Cedar Creek School, we believe every student has the ability to succeed when provided with the appropriate instruction, support, and encouragement. CCAP is built upon the belief that students with learning differences deserve access to high-quality, research-based instruction that develops academic skills, builds confidence, and promotes independence.

CCAP is not a tutoring or homework assistance program. It is a specialized educational program that provides individualized instruction, remediation, progress monitoring, and academic support through highly qualified learning specialists.

CCAP Services: The Cedar Creek Accelerated Program offers a comprehensive continuum of academic support services, including:

- Specialized CCAP Instruction
- After-School Tutoring
- Academic Consultations
- Academic Skills Screenings
- CCAP Placement Evaluations
- Summer Academic Support Services (as available)

All services are provided by highly qualified learning specialists using research-based instructional methods and evidence-based interventions.

Eligibility and Placement: Enrollment in CCAP is based upon demonstrated educational need rather than parent request. Placement recommendations are based on one or more of the following:

- Educational evaluations
- Classroom performance
- Teacher recommendations
- Parent conferences
- Academic assessment data
- Professional judgment of the CCAP staff

Placement in CCAP is determined through educational evaluations, classroom performance, teacher recommendations, parent conferences, and administrative review. Final placement decisions are made by the CCAP leadership team in consultation with the Associate Head of School for Academics.

To preserve the quality of instruction and maintain small instructional groups, enrollment is subject to available staffing and program capacity.

CCAP Service Levels

CCAP Intervention (Level I)

Annual Program Fee: \$1,500

Students receive specialized intervention approximately two to three times each week while remaining enrolled in their regular English Language Arts and Mathematics classes.

Instruction is provided in small-group or individual settings and focuses on strengthening foundational academic skills through targeted intervention.

Services may include:

- Dyslexia intervention
- Multisensory reading instruction
- Multisensory mathematics instruction
- Executive functioning strategies
- Progress monitoring
- Organization and study skills
- Individualized learning support

CCAP Daily Single-Subject Instruction (Level II)

Annual Program Fee: \$3,000

Students receive daily specialized instruction through CCAP in either English Language Arts or Mathematics.

The CCAP learning specialist assumes responsibility for:

- Daily instruction
- Lesson planning
- Curriculum implementation
- Assessment and grading
- Progress monitoring
- Parent communication

Students remain enrolled with their grade-level peers for all other academic courses and extracurricular activities.

CCAP Daily Dual-Subject Instruction (Level III)

Annual Program Fee: \$5,000

Students receive daily specialized instruction through CCAP in both English Language Arts and Mathematics. CCAP learning specialists assume responsibility for instruction, grading, lesson planning, assessment, grading, progress monitoring, and parent communication in both academic subjects. Students continue to participate in all remaining academic classes, athletics, clubs, and extracurricular activities.

Semiannual Review: Each student's placement and level of service shall be reviewed at least once each semester. Adjustments may be made based upon student progress, updated educational data, classroom performance, and recommendations from the CCAP staff. Students demonstrating sustained academic independence may transition to a lower level of support or exit the program upon recommendation of the CCAP staff.

Program Fees and Payment: CCAP Program Fees are assessed annually in addition to the published Cedar Creek School tuition. These fees support:

- Specialized instructional staff
- Individualized instruction
- Specialized curriculum
- Assessment materials
- Progress monitoring
- Instructional resources
- Professional development

Program fees may be paid according to the family's selected tuition payment plan. Except under extraordinary circumstances approved by the Head of School, CCAP Program Fees become non-refundable after the first thirty (30) calendar days of enrollment.

After-School Tutoring: CCAP offers optional after-school tutoring for Cedar Creek students who desire additional academic support beyond the regular school day. After-school tutoring is separate from a student's CCAP placement and may be recommended by teachers, requested by parents, or scheduled to provide additional academic assistance.

Available Tutoring Services

- Reading
- English Language Arts
- Mathematics
- Study skills
- Organization and executive functioning
- Test preparation
- Specialized intervention provided by CCAP learning specialists

Tutoring Fees

Service	Fee
Individual Tutoring with a Cedar Creek Teacher	\$60 per hour
Individual Tutoring with a CCAP Learning Specialist	\$75 per hour
Small Group Tutoring (2–4 students)	\$40 per student per hour

Tutoring sessions are scheduled through Cedar Creek School and are based upon teacher availability. Payment is made directly to Cedar Creek School.

Academic Consultations are available for current Cedar Creek families as well as prospective families seeking guidance regarding a student's academic performance or learning profile. Families may schedule an Academic Consultation to discuss a student's academic performance, learning profile, executive functioning, accommodations, or intervention recommendations.

Consultations may include:

- Review of previous educational evaluations
- Interpretation of assessment results
- Learning strategy recommendations
- Accommodation planning
- Academic planning
- Executive functioning guidance
- Recommendations for school or outside services

Fee: \$150 per consultation

Consultations are approximately 60 to 90 minutes and include a written summary of recommendations.

CCAP Placement Evaluation: The CCAP Placement Evaluation is conducted to determine whether a student would benefit from specialized services provided through CCAP.

The evaluation may include:

- Review of educational records
- Review of previous evaluations
- Individual academic assessments
- Parent interview
- Teacher input
- Placement recommendations
- Written evaluation summary

Fee: \$500

Students enrolling in CCAP during the same academic year will receive a \$250 credit toward their first CCAP Program Fee.

Parent Partnership: Student success is strengthened through an active partnership between home and school. Parents are expected to:

- Maintain regular communication with CCAP staff.
- Support recommended instructional strategies at home.
- Ensure consistent attendance.
- Participate in conferences regarding their child's academic progress.

Confidentiality: Student evaluations, assessment data, instructional records, and all educational information maintained through CCAP are treated as confidential educational records and managed in accordance with Cedar Creek School policies and applicable laws governing student privacy.

Summer CCAP Services: Based upon staffing and enrollment, CCAP may offer summer services including:

- Academic intervention
- Tutoring
- Academic Skills Screenings
- Academic Consultations
- CCAP Placement Evaluations

Summer offerings and applicable fees will be published annually.

Scheduling and Payment

- All Academic Support Services are scheduled through Cedar Creek School.
- Fees are billed through the Business Office.
- Families may use their established tuition payment method unless otherwise approved.
- Private payment arrangements between families and Cedar Creek employees for CCAP services are not permitted.
